Notice of Water Right Application T033460

Siskiyou County Flood Control and Water Conservation District (SCFCD) filed a temporary water right permit application with the State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board), Division of Water Rights, pursuant to Water Code section 1425 et seq. The project associated with the application is located in Siskiyou County and would divert water from the Shasta River stream system. The Applicant requests authorization to appropriate surface water for underground storage as described below.

Summary of Water Right Application T033460

Type of Temporary Permit: 180-Day Temporary Permit

Date of Filing: The application was filed with the State Water Board on October 7, 2024.

Source of Water: The source of water is the Shasta River, which is tributary to Klamath River, thence the Pacific Ocean.

Amount: The maximum amount of water requested for diversion is 4,800 acre-feet, which would be diverted at a rate not to exceed 40 cubic feet per second.

Season of Diversion: The season for diversion of water would be from December 1, 2024 to March 31, 2025.

Point of Diversion: The point where water would be diverted is located at North 2,469,820 feet and East 6,431,740 feet by California Coordinate System, Zone 1, North American Datum 1983, within the NW (¼) quarter of the NW (¼) quarter of Section 6, Township 43 North, Range 5 West, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.

Purpose of Use: The purpose of use for water is Domestic and Irrigation.

Place of Use: The water would be applied within the Grenada Irrigation District (GID) service area to parcels adjacent to the GID service ditch via flood irrigation. The place of use is 1,477 acres of the GID service area. Refer to map contained in attachments to application submittal.

Location and Type of Infiltration: Diverted water would be infiltrated to groundwater storage through the GID Service Ditch, which extends from GID Pumpstation (also the location of the POD) through the GID service area and is 7 miles long. Water would also be delivered by the Service Ditch to on-farm recharge areas for infiltration to underground storage. Refer to map contained in attachments to application submittal.

Use Accounting: The water stored underground through this temporary permit typically would be used within one year of infiltration to storage, through domestic use and irrigation use in the following growing season.

Procedure for Filing Objections

Pursuant to Water Code section 1428, any interested person may file an objection against the approval of the subject application. Objections should be submitted via email to the staff contact listed below but may also be submitted via regular mail or hand delivered. If objections are sent by mail or hand delivered, please provide a courtesy email to the staff contact listed below.

Objections must be received by the Division of Water Rights or postmarked by **November 20, 2024**, with copy provided to the applicant. The State Water Board may, for good cause shown, allow additional time to file an objection.

Pursuant to Water Code section 1428, the board may issue a temporary permit in advance of public notice. Consequently, a temporary permit may be issued on the application before the end of the noticing period.
