In addition, the construction of Interstate 5 severed the western portion of the place of use from the original point of diversion. The changes are being requested to reflect current ownership of the parcels and points of diversion used since the construction of Interstate 5 within the place of use.

Proposed Points of Diversion

- (1) within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of projected Section 19,
- (2) within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ projected Section 18, drainage tributary to Lost Slough
- (3) moveable point of diversion; ranges from SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of projected Section 19 to SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of projected Section 20, all within T5N, R5E, MDB&M, as shown on attached map.

Requested Additional Source of Diversion

The property located north of Twin Cities Road is irrigated from a drainage canal tributary to Lost Slough as shown on the attached map. The property has been irrigated from this location since the construction of Interstate 5 severed the property from the original point of diversion. The property is north of Twin Cities Road and is also severed from the southern parcel which is irrigated directly from Lost Slough.

There are no current permitted appropriators between the point of diversion on the drainage canal and the confluence of the drainage and Lost Slough. The total quantity of water diverted from Lost Slough and the drainage tributary to Lost Slough does not exceed the authorized quantity of diversion, and there is no increase in the authorized place of use. Therefore, the diversion of water from the drainage will not result in an injury to any other authorized appropriator.
