This right is part of the aggregate amount of water diverted from the Unnamed Spring and Fern Creek that serves the Down-Canyon System Service Area. Water diverted from the Unnamed Spring is treated for use at the Petersen Water Treatment Plant and water diverted from Fern Creek is treated at the Clark Water Treatment Plant. The Permit also allows water to be diverted from an additional unnamed stream and two unnamed springs, but diversion facilities at these locations have not been constructed. The total amount of water that can be diverted under Applications 5425, 9432, 11892, 12060, 17120, 20349, 26192 and 28609 is about 215.2 acre-feet annually. Per the District's July 2004 Master Water Plan, the Down Canyon Water System provides water to approximately 112 developed acres with 141 acres yet to be developed. Of the 141 acres yet to be developed 75 acres is limited by strict federal wetland development guidelines. These water sources have been constructed but additional time is needed to fully maximize the diversions under this permit. Growth has been gradual over the last 25 years.
