Season:	December 15 of each year to March 31 of the following year
Purpose of Use:	Present: Irrigation and frost protection Proposed: The addition of heat control and fire protection
Place of Use:	Present: 12 acres within NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$, 7 acres within SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$, and 8 acres within SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$, all within projected Section 28, T9N, R8W, MDB&M (27 acres total) Proposed: (1) The addition of 26 acres for a total of 53 acres of which 17 acres are within NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$, 7 acres within NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$, 8 acres within SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$, 17 acres within SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$, and 4 acres within NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$; and (2) use at the reservoir within SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ and SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$, all within projected Section 28, T9N, R8W, MDB&M
