1. Description of Changes to Project

Millview County Water District holds License 492 (Application 3601). This right allows Millview to pump from Millview Well No. 6 located in the NE 1/4 of SE 1/4 of projected Section 5, T15N, R12W, MDB&M. Well No. 6 has been abandoned due to poor water quality and lack of sufficient treatment. This Petition requests a change in the place of use, points of diversion and purpose of use authorized under License 492.

This Petition requests the addition of four existing Russian River diversion facilities and an existing Well Field as PODs under this License. The facilities will be used to provide service to Millview's customers. Two of the Russian River facilities, referred to as the Upper and Lower Russian River diversions (proposed POD Nos. 3 and 4) and the Well Field (proposed POD No. 5) are all located within the NE 1/4 of SE 1/4 of projected Section 5, T15N, R12W, MDB&M. The Well Field is a 7.15 acre parcel that contains multiple wellheads, a 0.5-acre gravel recharge basin and a treatment plant. Water diverted from proposed POD Nos. 3 and 4 will be conveyed directly to Millview's treatment plant or used to recharge the existing gravel basin to raise the water levels in the well field. The remaining Russian River diversion facilities proposed by this Petition are referred to as POD Nos. 6 and 7 (Masonite Well Nos. 3 and 5, respectively). POD Nos. 6 and 7 are located within the NW 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of projected Section 9, T15N, R12W, MDB&M.

The Petition also requests an increase in the place of use authorized under the License to include surveyed, fractional, or projected Sections 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 16, 17 and 18 of T15N, R12W MDB&M and surveyed, fractional, or projected Sections 20, 21, 28, 29, 30, 31, 32, 33, and 34 of T16N, R12W, MDB&M. The place of use is also shown on the map labeled Attachment 2 of the Petition for Change.

Additionally, the Petition requests the addition of irrigation as a purpose of use.

No other changes will result from this Petition.
