Below are additional items of information requested in your letter dated Oct 31, 2008.

1) Name and Address of Petitioner:

2) Non injury information:

- a. The additional point of diversion is directly downstream from my other point of diversion. No additional landowner is between these points. The upstream diversion is a splashboard dam which provides water to me and three other riparian users. The dam was recently permitted by the Department of Fish and Game under DFG 1600-2004-0917-3. Terms of the Agreement require 80% flow bypass to reduce the pulse removal of flow. My new diversion will be used to provide a constant 50 gal/min supply to a regulatory pond and reduce the pulse flow from the dam to the pond without increasing take of water from the stream.

Downstream diverters also use the dam as water supply and do not divert below my property. But if they add a diversion point downstream, the water availability remains the same.

3) I.D of Rights:

- a. Existing and proposed points of diversion and return flow:
i. Present: Dam N37,29.534'; W122,26.120'
ii. Additional: N37,29.207'; W122,26.240'
iii. No return flow.
- b. Places of use: no change. Map attached.
- c. Diversion info: diversion total is unchanged; stream flow regime change is not measurable within the stream system. Diversion max potential is 0.101 CFS.
- d. Effects to wildlife: No effects are anticipated. A 1600 application to DFG has been submitted with appropriate protection measures.
- e. Preliminary info, maps and consultation with DFG: Maps and effects information are attached and consultation with DFG has been requested.
