### NOTICE OF PETITION FOR CHANGE AND FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME FOR PERMIT 17593 (APPLICATION 24955)

COUNTY: Mendocino

STREAM SYSTEM: Russian River

#### Summary of Permit

Source:	East Fork Russian River tributary to Russian River and Lake Mendocino tributary to East Fork Russian River.
Points of Diversion (POD):	<b>No Change:</b> POD 1 (coyote dam) within NE <sup>1</sup> / <sub>4</sub> of SW <sup>1</sup> / <sub>4</sub> , Section 34; POD 2 within NW <sup>1</sup> / <sub>4</sub> of NE <sup>1</sup> / <sub>4</sub> , Section 27, both within T16N, R12W, MDB&M; POD 3: Various reservoirs within boundaries of Redwood Valley County Water District.
Amount & Season:	<b>No Change:</b> 26.6 cubic feet per second by direct diversion, from March 1 to April 30; 1.9 cubic feet per second by direct diversion from November 1 to April 30; 2800 acre-feet by storage, from November 1 to April 30. Total Amount of water to be taken from the source for all uses shall not exceed 4900 acre-feet per water year of October 1 to September 30.
Purpose of Use:	<b>No Change:</b> Irrigation, Frost Protection and Domestic Uses.
Place of Use:	<b>Present:</b> A net area of 3,300 acres within a gross area of 5,000 acres and other given uses within the boundaries of the District in T16N and T17N, R12W, MDB&M, as shown on a map on file with the State Water Resources Control Board. <b>Proposed:</b> Petitioner seeks to add five (5) additional areas to its place of use which were previously annexed by the District so it is consistent with the District's current boundary. The properties, totaling 534.16 acres, are described as follows: 34 acres ("Garzini") within Section 17, and 15 acres ("Weibel") within Section 16, T16N, R12W, MDB&M; 295 acres ("Fetzer") within Section 12, T16N, R13W, MDB&M; 40.56 acres ("Gabrieli") within Section 30, and 149.6 acres ("Rancheria") within Sections 34 & 35, T17N, R12W, MDB&M. The net irrigable area of 3,300 acres within a gross irrigable area of 5,000 acres will not change. The amended place of use is within the boundaries of the Redwood Valley County Water District in T16 and 17N, R12 and 13W, MDB&M as shown on the map on file with the State Water Resources Control Board.
Petition for Extension of Time	Petitioner has requested a ten (10) year extension of time until December 31, 2012 to fully develop the project and put water to full beneficial use as authorized under Permit 17593 (Application 24955).
