The majority of the project is complete and in use. Del Valle Reservoir is complete and in use, water treatment facilities have been completed and water measuring stations have been developed. During the period of time requested in this Petition for Extension of Time the petitioner plans to develop a number of gravel mining pits that are currently being utilized as active mining pits. Once mining operations cease (believed to be in the year 2030) Zone 7 will take control of the pits to use them as storage and percolating basins to store storm water that cannot currently be captured in Del Valle Reservoir.
