The City of Visalia is currently in the design phase of a major upgrade to its Water Conservation Plant (WCP). Construction of the project is expected to begin 4th quarter 2011. As part of the project, the City will discontinue discharging to its primary discharge point, Mill Creek, and will begin an aggressive water recycling program.

The City has applied for financial assistance from the State Revolving Fund program. As part of that application process, a Water Rights determination is required. Therefore, the City is submitting this Petition for Change, along with applicable fees.
