Point of Diversion:	Sugar Pine Dam: NE ¹ / ₄ of SW ¹ / ₄ of Section 24, T15N, R10E, MDB&M
Point of Rediversion	Regulating Reservoir: SE ¹ / ₄ of NW ¹ / ₄ of Section 24, T14N, 10E, MDB&M
Amount:	18 cubic feet per second by direct diversion; and 15,400 acre-feet per annum by storage
Season:	About November 1 of each year to about July 1 of the succeeding year
Purpose of Use:	Irrigation, municipal, industrial, domestic, recreational, and fishery maintenance and enhancement
Place of Use:	Sections 3 - 6 of T14N, R10E; Sections 13, 24 - 27, 33 - 36, of T15N, R10E; Sections 17 - 20 of T15N, R11E, MDB&M.
