Place of Use

Proposed:

The proposed use is as recycled water by the member of the Western Riverside County Regional Wastewater Authority (WRCRWA). WRCRWA would deliver tertiary treated recycled water to the member agencies at the treatment plant. Member agencies would deliver the recycled water to specific use areas under their jurisdiction. The member agencies would provide for the ultimate use under their individual recycled water permits.

Item 2:

Purpose of Use Proposed:

The proposed use is as recycled water by the member agencies of WRCRWA for appropriate uses as specified in Title 22. The member agencies would obtain the applicable permits and approvals from the Regional Water Quality Control Board and the California Department of Public Health for use of the recycled water.

WRCRA's member agencies are committed to the decreasing the dependency on imported water and increasing water supply reliability. This action would provide up to an additional 16 million gallons per day (18,000 acre feet per year) of recycled water to replace potable water currently used for purposes appropriate for recycled water.

The place of use of the recycled water diverted from the current discharge point will be the under the jurisdiction of the member agencies. The recycled water will be transferred to member agency control at the wastewater treatment plant owned by WRCRWA.

The member agencies would obtain the appropriate permits and approvals from the Regional Water Quality Control Board and the California Department of Public Health for beneficial use of the recycled water.

Item 4.

Give name and address of any person(s) taking water from the stream between the present point(s) of discharge and the proposed point(s) of rediversion, as well as any other person(s) known to you who may be affected by the proposed discharge.

There are no entities that divert water between the current WRCRWA discharge and the points of beneficial reuse as recycled water. Recycled water will be transferred to WRCRWA member agencies at the treatment plant.

Orange County Water District (OCWD) may be potentially affected by the proposed reduction in flow to the diversion channel to the Prado Basin. Flow to the Santa Ana River, and hence to the Prado Basin, is regulated by the 1969 Santa Ana River Judgement (Attachment 3). However, the WRCRWA was not party to the 1969 Santa Ana River Judgement and all judgement parties will continue to satisfy their obligations under the agreement.

Water sources for wastewater influent from WRCRWA members consist of water foreign to the Santa Ana River. WRCRWA members use water imported from the State Water Project and the Colorado River and pumped local groundwater. No native Santa Ana River water is process through the WRCRWA treatment plant. Additionally, WRCRWA's historic discharges are a fraction of the total wastewater discharges to the Santa Ana River above Prado Dam (on average about 2.3 percent).
