**NOTICE OF WASTEWATER CHANGE PETITION WW0078**

COUNTY: Riverside                      STREAM SYSTEM: Temescal Creek

Eastern Municipal Water District (EMWD) has filed a wastewater change petition, seeking to reduce the discharge of treated wastewater to Temescal Creek. Approximately 900 acre-feet of storage capacity will be added to EMWD's existing capacity through construction of a pond. The initial filling of the pond could reduce EMWD's discharge in that year. Summary of Wastewater Discharge

Point of Discharge	Present: Intermittent discharge in Riverside County, 40 feet upstream of the confluence of Wasson Canyon flood control channel and Reach 5 of Temescal Creek (Latitude 33°40'52"N, Longitude 11°19'54"W). Proposed: No change.
Amount:	Present: varies from zero to 17,000 acre-feet per year depending on demand and rainfall. Proposed: No change.
Purpose of Use:	Present: Agricultural, Municipal and Industrial. Proposed: No change.
Place of Use:	Present: EMWD's Recycled Water Ponds Expansion and Optimization Project service area (17,444 acres). Proposed: No change.
Season:	January 1 to December 31 of each year.
