NOTICE OF WASTEWATER CHANGE PETITION WW0082

COUNTY: Mendocino

STREAM SYSTEM: Russian River

The City of Ukiah has filed a wastewater change petition with the State Water Resources Control Board pursuant to Water Code section 1211. The petition seeks authorization to change the purpose of use and place of use of treated wastewater discharged from the Ukiah Wastewater Treatment Plant. The subject treated wastewater would be redirected to offset water demands for irrigation and frost protection use within the Ukiah Valley and reduce treated wastewater discharges to the Russian River. The Petition includes a table identifying the projected estimates of changes to discharge rates.

Maximum rate of discharge:	Present: Not to exceed 1% of the flow of the Russian River measured at USGS gage 11462500 (Russian River Near Hopland) Proposed: No change
Purpose of Use:	Present: None Proposed: Irrigation and frost protection
Place of Use:	Present: None Proposed: Approximately 987 acres of existing agricultural and urban landscape irrigation lands within the Ukiah Valley
Season:	October 1 through May 14 of the succeeding year
