Proposed: No change.

Present: Salinas River, Monterey County, downstream of Davis Road. Latitude 36°38'53"N, longitude 121°42'18"W (California Coordinate System NAD 83, Zone 4, North 2,130,210 feet, East 5,768,244 feet). See Figure 2-22, Attachment 1.

Proposed: Seaside Groundwater Basin and Castroville Seawater Intrusion Project area. See Attachment 1 - Project Map, Attachment 2 - Legal Descriptions, and Attachment 3 - Underground Storage Supplement.

Purpose of Use

Present: None.

Proposed: Municipal, irrigation (12,000 acres). Municipal use will be for injection of highly treated recycled water into the Seaside Groundwater Basin and subsequent extraction to the Cal-Am system for delivery to Monterey Peninsula customers.
