Dear Ms. Lee:

Enclosed are: (i) a Petition to add a point of diversion to Permit No. 7847; (ii) check # 122790, payable to the State Water Resources Control Board in the amount of \$1,412.50; and (iii) check # 122785, payable to the California Department of Fish & Wildlife in the amount of \$850.

The City of Healdsburg seeks to add a point of diversion to Permit No. 7847 because water treatment facilities at the existing point of diversion are inadequate to treat water to potable levels when water quality is poor. The City already uses the proposed new point of diversion to divert water under a separate water right, and there are adequate treatment facilities at that point of diversion. Thus, adding the new point of diversion will simply allow the City to continue putting water diverted pursuant to Permit No. 7847 to beneficial uses.



Applicant City of Healdsburg ("City") seeks to add a point of diversion to Permit No. 7847 (Application No. A013217). The City seeks this change because currently the water treatment facilities available at the current point of diversion are not adequate to treat water to potable levels when water quality in the Russian River is poor. Russian River diversions are a crucial source of the City bunicipal supply, and so it is imperative that the City be able to properly treat and deliver Russian River water pursuant to Permit 7847. Adequate water treatment facilities are present at the proposed new point of diversion, so the proposed change will allow the City to make beneficial use of water under Permit 7847 even when water quality is poor.

The only effect of the proposed change will be that the City will be able to divert water under Permit 7847 at an additional point of diversion. The City currently diverts water at the proposed new point of diversion under a separate water right, and so all necessary diversion facilities are in place - no additional construction or other activity that could affect the environment is required. No other changes to Permit 7847 are requested at this time: the amount of water to be diverted, season of diversion, and places and purposes of use will be the same.
