NOTICE OF WASTEWATER CHANGE PETITION WW0095

COUNTY: San Bernardino

STREAM SYSTEM: Santa Ana River

The San Bernardino Valley Municipal Water District (District) has filed a wastewater change petition with the State Water Resources Control Board pursuant to Water Code section 1211. The petition requests authorization to change the point of discharge and to reduce the rate and volume of treated wastewater generated by East Valley Water District and discharged from the City of San Bernardino's Rapid Infiltration and Exfiltration Facility to the Santa Ana River during all months of the year.
