Sonoma Valley County Sanitation District (District) has filed a wastewater change petition with the State Water Resources Control Board pursuant to Water Code section 1211. The District requests authorization to reduce the rate and volume of treated wastewater discharged from three existing outfalls located at Schell Slough and Fly Bay from November 1 to April 30 of the succeeding year. This change is part of the North Bay Water Reuse Program whose purpose is to provide recycled water for agricultural, urban, and environmental uses in the North San Pablo Bay region.
