Description of Proposed Changes or Work Remaining to Be Completed

The Petitioner is filing a Petition for Change to add existing Point 8 (Cooksley Lake) as a Point of Rediversion for water diverted at Point 7 and to change the distribution of storage authorized by Permit 11570 to add Cooksley Lake as an authorized place of storage.

The Petition requests that no changes be made to the authorized rate or amount of diversion. The maximum rate of direct diversion would equal the 1.783 cfs rate currently authorized for direct diversion, and the maximum storage amount would continue to be 45 acre-feet per year, as now authorized by Permit 11570. The maximum rate of diversion to off-stream storage would continue to be 10 cfs. The Petitioner seeks to maintain the places of use currently authorized for municipal and irrigation uses under Permit 11570. The requested changes would not result in any increase in the rate or amount of water diverted under the Permit.

Because the changes requested in the Petition would not result in any change to the amount of water diverted, or the rate or season of diversion, fish and wildlife would not be affected by the requested change. Similarly, because there is no change to the flows in the stream below the points of diversion, the Petition would not injure any other legal user of water. As the changes requested in this Petition do not have the potential to impair instream beneficial uses due to a decrease in flow, it is our understanding that this Petition is also not subject to the requirements for diversion season, minimum bypass flow, and maximum cumulative diversion set forth in the *Policy for Maintaining Instream Flows in Northern California Coastal Streams*.

The Petitioner intends to reconstruct a portion of the existing transfer ditch from a point west of Deer Lake to Cooksley Lake to allow for water diverted at Point 7 to be conveyed to Cooksley Lake. This activity would constitute maintenance of an existing facility. No new construction is proposed.

The requested changes do not involve modification of any existing reservoirs, construction of new diversion facilities or modification of the requested place of use. This Petition will not increase the existing diversion or use of water relative to historical conditions for this project. Accordingly, this Petition qualifies for a Categorical Exemption under Title 14, California Code of Regulations, Section 15301, Existing Facilities, which states the following:

"Class 1 consists of the operation, repair, maintenance, permitting, leasing, licensing, or minor alteration of existing public or private structures, facilities, mechanical equipment, or topographical features, involving negligible or no expansion of use beyond that existing at the time of the lead agency's determination."

Proposed Distribution of Storage

The Petitioner requests no change in the total authorized storage amount of 45 acre-feet per year. The Petitioner is requesting that the amount authorized for storage under Permit 11570 not only be authorized for storage in Deer Lake, but also for storage in Cooksley Lake. The combined total amount authorized for storage under Permit 11570 would not change.
