NOTICE OF WASTEWATER CHANGE PETITION WW0104

COUNTY: Los Angeles STREAM SYSTEM: San Jose Creek/San

Gabriel River

The Sanitation Districts of Los Angeles County (Petitioner) has filed a wastewater change petition with the State Water Resources Control Board, Division of Water Rights (Division) pursuant to Water Code section 1211. The Petitioner requests authorization to reduce the discharge of treated wastewater down to zero from the Pomona Water Reclamation Plant to the upper watershed of San Jose Creek during all months of the year based on recycled water demand.
