### NOTICE OF WASTEWATER CHANGE PETITION WW0106

COUNTY: Los Angeles STREAM SYSTEM: San Gabriel River

The Sanitation Districts of Los Angeles County (Petitioner) has filed a wastewater change petition with the State Water Resources Control Board, Division of Water Rights (Division) pursuant to Water Code section 1211. The Petitioner requests authorization to reduce the discharge of treated wastewater down to 2.0 million gallons per day from the Los Coyotes Water Reclamation Plant to the lower portion of the San Gabriel River watershed during all months of the year based on recycled water demand.
