Description of Proposed Changes or Work Remaining to be Completed

License 5880 (Application 014489)

Through this Petition, Licensee seeks to change the place of use from the 4.75 acres currently authorized to the 38 acres of existing vineyard that are currently developed and being served, as shown on the attached map. The pond identified as the point of diversion and place of storage in this License is also identified as the point of diversion and place of storage for License 12341, which authorizes irrigation of a separate property. Licensee is requesting to change the place of use under this License and in a companion petition for License 12341, that is concurrently being filed, to change the place of use to cover the same existing 38 acres of developed lands on both properties. This will allow water diverted under either right to be used on either property. The project is fully developed, and no further development is requested.

Although this Petition requests an increase in place of use, no increase in the amount of water used under this right is proposed. This License authorizes a maximum diversion of 4 acre-feet per year. It was issued in 1959 for irrigation uses. When this License was issued in 1959, sprinklers were used to irrigate 0.25 acres of "truck farm" crops and 4.5 acres of orchard within the place of use. Due to the change in crop type (from truck farm crops and orchards to only grapes), advancement in irrigation practices, and the current use of drip irrigation, the same amount of water used to irrigate 4.75 acres of truck farm crops and orchards in 1959 is capable of irrigating a much larger area of vineyards today, which allows an expansion in place of use without an increase in water use above the licensed amount.

License 12341 (Application 024505)

Through this Petition, Licensee seeks to change the authorized place of use from the three acres currently authorized to the 38 acres of existing vineyard that are currently developed as shown on the attached map (the same 38 acre referenced in the description for License 5880). The pond identified as the point of diversion and place of storage in this License is also identified as the point of diversion and place of storage for License 5880, which authorizes irrigation of a separate property. Licensee is requesting to change the place of use under this License and in a companion petition for License 5008, that is concurrently being filed, to change the place of use to cover the same existing 38 acres of developed lands on both properties. This will allow water diverted under either right to be used on either property. The project is fully developed and no further development is requested.

Although this Petition requests an increase in place of use, no increase in the amount of water used under this right is proposed. This License authorizes maximum diversions of 6 acre-feet per year but restricts combined annual water use under this License and License 5880 to 6.6 acre-feet. When this License was issued in 1987, water diverted under this License was used to serve "a home and horses" and also to drip irrigate 3 acres of vineyard. Due to advancement in irrigation practices and the change to solely a vineyard irrigation use, the same amount of water used to irrigate three acres of vineyard and serve domestic and stockwatering uses in 1987 is capable of irrigating a much larger area of vineyards today, which allows an expansion in place of use without an increase in water use above the licensed amount.




Point of Diversion #1 - Typical Place of use and Pond named in Licenses 5880 and 12341



Point of Diversion #1 – On Dam Looking Upstream








