THIS IS TO CERTIFY, That Belta Farms Reclamation District No. 2026 of

of Water Resources of California of a right to the use of the waters of (1) San Joaquin River. (2) Old River. (3) False River. (4) Washington Slough. and (5) an unnamed dreager cut along the west side of said District. In Contra Costa County tributary of (1) Suisun Bay, and (2). (3). (4) and (5) San Joaquin River

for the purpose of irrigation use under Permit 1416 of the Division of Water Resources and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of California, the rules and regulations of the Division of Water Resources and the terms of the said permit; that the priority of the right herein confirmed dates from 22. 1922:

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to the amount actually beneficially used for said purposes and shall not exceed sixty-three and ninety-four hundredths (63.94) cubic feet per second from about March let to about Movember 1st of each season. In case of rotation the equivalent of such continuous flow allowance for any thirty day period may be diverted in a shorter time if there be no interference with other vested rights.

The point of diversion of such animalization movable along the shore line of Reclamation District No. 2026 in Sections 19, 30 and 31, T 3 H, R 4 E, M.D.B.&M., Sections 22, 23, 24, 27, 28, 33, 34, 35 and 36, T 3 H, R 3 E, M.D.B.&M., and Sections 3 and 4, T 2 H, R 3 E, M.D.B.&M. as shown on the map entitled "Webb Tract" filed July 28, 1922, with the Division of Water Resources, then Division of Water Resources.

A description of the lands or the place where such water is put to beneficial use is as follows:

5115.491 acres in Sections 13, 14, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, 28, 33, 34, 35 and
36, T 3 N, R 3 E, Sections 3 and 4, T 2 N, R 3 E, and Sections 19, 30 and 31,
T 3 N, R 4 E, N.D.B.&M. within the boundaries of Reclamation District No. 2026,
known as the "Webb Tract", as shown on the map of said tract filed July 28,
1922, with the Division of Water Resources, then Division of Water Rights.

As there is a possibility that there will not be sufficient water in the sources named during the latter part of the irrigation season to satisfy all requirements, this license is issued subject to the express condition that the diversions thereunder may be regulated by the Division of Water Resources during such periods of water scarcity to the end that the exercise of this license will not interfere with rights under prior applications.


In accordance with the provisions of Section 42 of the Water Commission Act, nothing herein shall be construed as confirming the right to use more than two and one-half (2) acre feet of water per acre in any one year in the irrigation of uncultivated areas of land not devoted to cultivated crops.

The right to the diversion and use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the point of diversion herein specified and to the lands or place of use herein described.

This license is granted and said appropriator takes all rights herein mentioned subject to the terms and conditions set forth in Section 20 of Chapter 586, Statutes 1913, which is as follows:
