This Petition seeks a temporary reduction of a bypass and release condition contained in License 9847 held by the City of Santa Cruz ("City"). The City requests a reduction from 1 cubic feet per second to 0.2 cubic feet per second in the bypass/release of water from its Newell Creek Reservoir that is made pursuant to the term in License 9847.

Newell Creek Reservoir is the City's only source of stored water for drought protection purposes. Absent meaningful precipitation events and the relief from the bypass and release requirement from Newell Creek Reservoir, the City's water supply will approach a dangerously low level for essential health and safety needs. The project named in this Petition will not require and changes or additions to facilities. All facilities are existing. This temporary change is being sought for 180 days from the date of petition approval. The City is the lead agency responsible for compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) for this Petition. The City is issuing a Notice of Exemption pursuant to CEQA for this project.
