### ORDER ALLOWING CHANGE IN POINTS OF DIVERSION

Licensee having established to the satisfaction of the State Engineer that the change in points of diversion under Application 575, Permit 314, License 1718 for which petition was submitted on October 25, 1951 will not operate to the injury of any other legal user of water, the State Engineer so finds, and

IT IS ORDERED that permission be and the same is hereby granted to change the points of diversion under said Application 575, Permit 314, License 1718 to points of diversion described as follows, to wit:

(1) TOWNSITE PLANT - NORTH FOURTEEN DEGREES EIGHTEEN MINUTES
FORTY SECONDS EAST (N 14° 18' 40" E) FOUR THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
SIXTY-SEVEN (4867) FEET FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 14, T 11 N,
R 2 E, M.D.B.&M., BEING WITHIN NW OF NW OF SAID SECTION 14, and
(2) EL DORADO BEND PLANT - NORTH FIFTY-THREE DEGREES EAST (N 53° E)
SIX THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED (6200) FEET FROM A POINT ON SYCAMORE
SLOUGH AT THE INTERSECTION OF THE SOUTH BOUNDARY OF RANCHO JIMENO
AND THE WEST LINE OF SECTION 31, T 12 N, R 2 E, M.D.B.&M., BEING
WITHIN NE OF SE OF PROJECTED SECTION 30, T 12 N, R 2 E, M.D.B.&M.

under Permit 314 of the Division of Water Resources and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of California, the rules and regulations of the Division of Water Resources and the terms of the said permit; that the priority of the right herein confirmed dates from January 25, 1917;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to the amount actually beneficially used for said purposes and shall not exceed thirty-two (32) cubic feet per second from about March let to about October 31st of each season. In case of rotation the equivalent of such continuous flow allowance for any thirty day period may be diverted in a shorter time if there be no interference with other vested rights.

The point s of diversion of such water are located (1) North seventeen degrees thirty minutes Rast (N. 17° 30° E.) forty-two hundred (4200) feet from corner common to Sections 14, 15, 22 and 23, T 11 N, R 2 E, M.D.B.&M., being within SW of NW1 of Projected Section 14, T 11 N, R 2 E, M.D.B.&M.

(2) North fifty-three degrees East (N. 53° E.) sixty-two hundred (6200) feet from a point on Sycamore Slough at the intersection of the south boundary of Rancho Jimeno and the west line of Section 31. T 12 N. R 2 E. M.D.B.&M., being within the NRt of SRt of Projected Section 30. T 12 N. R 2 E. M.D.B.&M.

A description of the lands or the place where such water is put to beneficial use is as follows: Thirty-five hundred eight and twenty-five hundredths (3508.25) acres in Sections 30, 31, 32 and 33, T 12 N, R 2 E, and Sections 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 14, 15 and 16, T 11 N, R 2 E, M.D.B.&M., bounded on the north and east by Elderado Ditch and Sycamore Slough, on the west by the east levee of Reclamation District 108 and on the south by Enights Landing Ridge Drainage District levee, all as shown on map entitled "A portion of the properties of River Farms Company of California," filed with the Division of Water Resources November 27, 1936.

As there is a possibility that there will not be sufficient water in Sagramente River during the latter part of the irrigation season to satisfy all requirements, this license is issued subject to the express condition that the use hereunder may be regulated by the Division of Water Resources during such periods of water scarcity to the end that such use will not interfere with rights under prior applications.

Reports shall be filed promptly by licensee on appropriate forms which will be provided for the purpose from time to time by the Division of Water Resources.

The right to the diversion and use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the point of diversion herein specified and to the lands or place of use herein described.

This license is granted and said appropriator takes all rights berein mentioned subject to the terms and conditions set forth in Section 20 of Chapter 586, Statutes 1913, which is as follows:

Sec. 20.
