Treated Waste Water Change Petition WW-2

ORDER APPROVING CHANGE IN THE POINT OF DISCHARGE, PLACE OF USE AND PURPOSE OF USE FOR TREATED WASTE WATER

WHEREAS:

- Treated Waste Water change petition WW-2 was filed by Plumas Pines, Inc. on November 30, 1987, pursuant to Sections 1210 and 1211 of the California Water Code.
- 2. On June 1, 1988, Plumas Pines, Inc. was bought by DiLoreto Plumas Limited, the new owner of record.
- 3. Staff of the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board, Region 5 stated that the project has been cleared to use its discharge for irrigational purposes.
- 4. The change petition was filed with the State Water Resources Control Board (Board) to obtain Board approval under Sections 1211 and 1700 of the California Water Code to change the Point of Discharge, Place of Use and Purpose of Use.
- 5. The Board has determined that good cause for the changes has been shown.
- The Board has determined that the changes do not constitute the initiation of a new right nor operate to the injury of any other lawful user of water.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED THAT:

- The Point of Discharge shall be at Waste Water Treatment Plant Number 6; within the NW4 of SE4 of Section 5, T22N, R12E, MDB&M.
- 2. Place of Use shall be as follows:
 - 6 acres within NE% of SW% of Section 5, T22N, R12E, MDB&M
 - 17 acres within NW% of SE% of Section 5, T22N, R12E, MDB&M

 - 11 acres within NE% of SE% of Section 5, T22N, R12E, MDB&M 17 acres within SE% of SE% of Section 5, T22N, R12E, MDB&M 16 acres within SW% of SE% of Section 5, T22N, R12E, MDB&M
 - 67 acres total
- 3. The Purpose of Use shall be irrigation.
