Treated Waste water Change Petition WW-5

**ORDER APPROVING CHANGE IN THE
POINT OF DISCHARGE, PLACE OF USE AND
PURPOSE OF USE FOR TREATED WASTE WATER**


WHEREAS:

1. Treated Waste Water change petition WW-5 was filed by Marin Municipal Water District on November 1, 1989, pursuant to Sections 1210 and 1211 of the California Water Code.
2. The change petition was filed with the State Water Resources Control Board (Board) to obtain Board approval under Sections 1211 and 1700 of the California Water Code to change the Point of Discharge, Place of Use and Purpose of Use.
3. The Board has determined that good cause for the changes has been shown.
4. The Board has determined that the changes do not constitute the initiation of a new right nor operate to the injury of any other lawful user of water.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The Point of Discharge shall be at Las Gallinas Valley Water Reclamation Plant within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of projected Section 15, T2N, R6W, MDB&M.
2. Place of Use shall be to irrigate golf courses, parks, pasture and landscape within portions of Rancho San Jose, Rancho San Pedro, Santa Margarita, Las Gallinas and Santa Venetia. The area is located within projected Sections 2, 3, 4, 8, 9, 10, 11, 15, 16, 17, 19, 20, 21, 22, 27, 28 and 29, T2N, R6W, MDB&M and projected Sections 33, 34 and 35, T3N, R6W, MDB&M, as shown on map on file with the State Water Resources Control Board.
3. The Purpose of Use shall be Irrigation.
