ORDER APPROVING CHANGE IN PLACE OF USE, AND PURPOSE OF USE OF TREATED WASTEWATER

WHEREAS:

- 1. Treated Wastewater change petition WW-24 was filed by the Las Virgenes Municipal Water District on March 8, 1994 pursuant to Sections 1210 and 1211 of the California Water Code.
- 2. The change petition was filed with the State Water Resources Control Board (SWRCB) to obtain approval under Sections 1211 and 1700 of the California Water Code to change the place of use and purpose of use of up to 5,200 acre-feet of treated wastewater discharged from the Tapia Water Reclamation Facility tributary to Malibu Creek thence Pacific Ocean in Los Angeles County.
- 3. The SWRCB has determined that good cause for the changes has been shown.
- 4. The SWRCB has determined that the changes do not constitute the initiation of a new right nor operate to the injury of any other lawful user of water.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The source of treated wastewater is the Tapia Water Reclamation Facility tributary to Malibu Creek thence Pacific Ocean in Los Angeles County; located within the SW% of NW% of Section 18, T1S, R17W, MDB&M. California Coordinate System, Zone 7, North 4,157,450, East 4,073,500.

2. The purpose of use shall be irrigation.

- 3. The place of use shall be within the Los Virgenes Municipal Water District, the Triunfo Sanitation District service areas; and the Oak Park/North Ranch Reclaimed Water Distribution system's service area: as shown on maps filed with the SWRCB. (0000004)
- 4. Maximum annual use is limited to 5,200 acre-feet of treated wastewater.
