Deirdre Des Jardins, principal at California Water Research, "California Water Research," joins in the concerns expressed this evening by LAND and Antioch about the scheduling of the testimony by the Department of Water Resources, given that the testimony was only provided on September 24, 2018. California Water Research has also not had adequate time to review DWR's witnesses testimony.

However, as stated in California Water Research's request this morning, California Water Research has two witnesses, Dr. Andrew Jahn and Dr. Tom Williams, who need to travel long distances to the hearing. Dr. Jahn is also testifying for PCFFA. Based on the schedule announced today by the Hearing Team at 4:30 pm, California Water Research and PCFFA worked with the witnesses to make travel arrangements.

California Water Research therefore requests that if testimony by DWR's witnesses is canceled, that California Water Research's witnesses not be required to testify before noon on September 26, 2018. The hearing could either start later or a minor change in presentation order could be arranged with Clifton Court LLP. (Clifton Court LLP previously agreed to the change.)
