**SUBJECT: INFORMATION FOR RECLAMATION DISTRICT 501, RYER ISLAND,  
LOCATED IN THE NORTHERN DELTA REGION OF SOLANO COUNTY**

Reclamation District 501, Ryer Island is located in the Northern Delta Region of Solano County. Reclamation District 501 is within the boundaries of both Ryer Island and the North Delta Water Agency. Reclamation District 501 consists of approximately 11,748 acres of irrigated agricultural land.

**Statement Information:**

A total of forty three Statements have been filed with the claim of riparian and pre-1914 water rights which includes the beneficial use of water from Cache Slough, Miner Slough, Steamboat Slough, and Sutter Slough. These forty three Statements represent forty three individual points of diversion which serves the parcels on Ryer Island. All Statement information filed has been accepted by the State Board's Division of Water Rights. The Reclamation District 501, Ryer Island file is complete.
