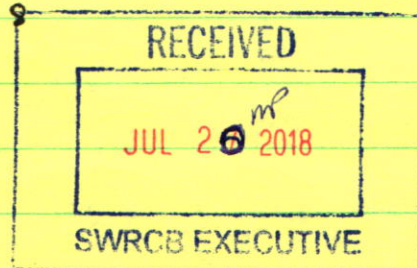

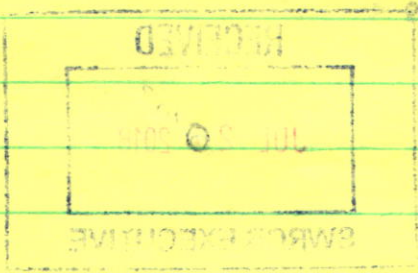
If 60% of the water remains for Ag and Industry, then 40% should be protected between February and June as the Water Board proposes.
