Comments	<p><i>I write to urge you to take more aggressive action than currently proposed in order to protect the San Francisco Bay estuary and its tributaries, including the Stanislaus, Tuolumne and Merced Rivers. The best available science clearly demonstrates that much more water from the Central Valley must flow into and through the Delta from Central Valley rivers than you have currently proposed (e.g., only 40% from the San Joaquin tributaries). Without adequate flow of fresh water in Central Valley Rivers and the Delta, Chinook salmon will continue to decline and may potentially be extirpated from the Central Valley. In addition, species found nowhere else on earth (e.g., Delta smelt) are likely to become extinct very soon unless the Water Board requires vastly improved protections for our Bay and its estuary. Finally, declining water quality in the Delta is a source of great concern to all Californians and freshwater flows greater than those currently proposed are needed to prevent toxic algae from blooming in the Delta. I urge you to provide greater protection for the San Francisco Bay estuary's aquatic resources -- people who use water for consumptive uses must conserve and apply ingenuity to do more with less.
