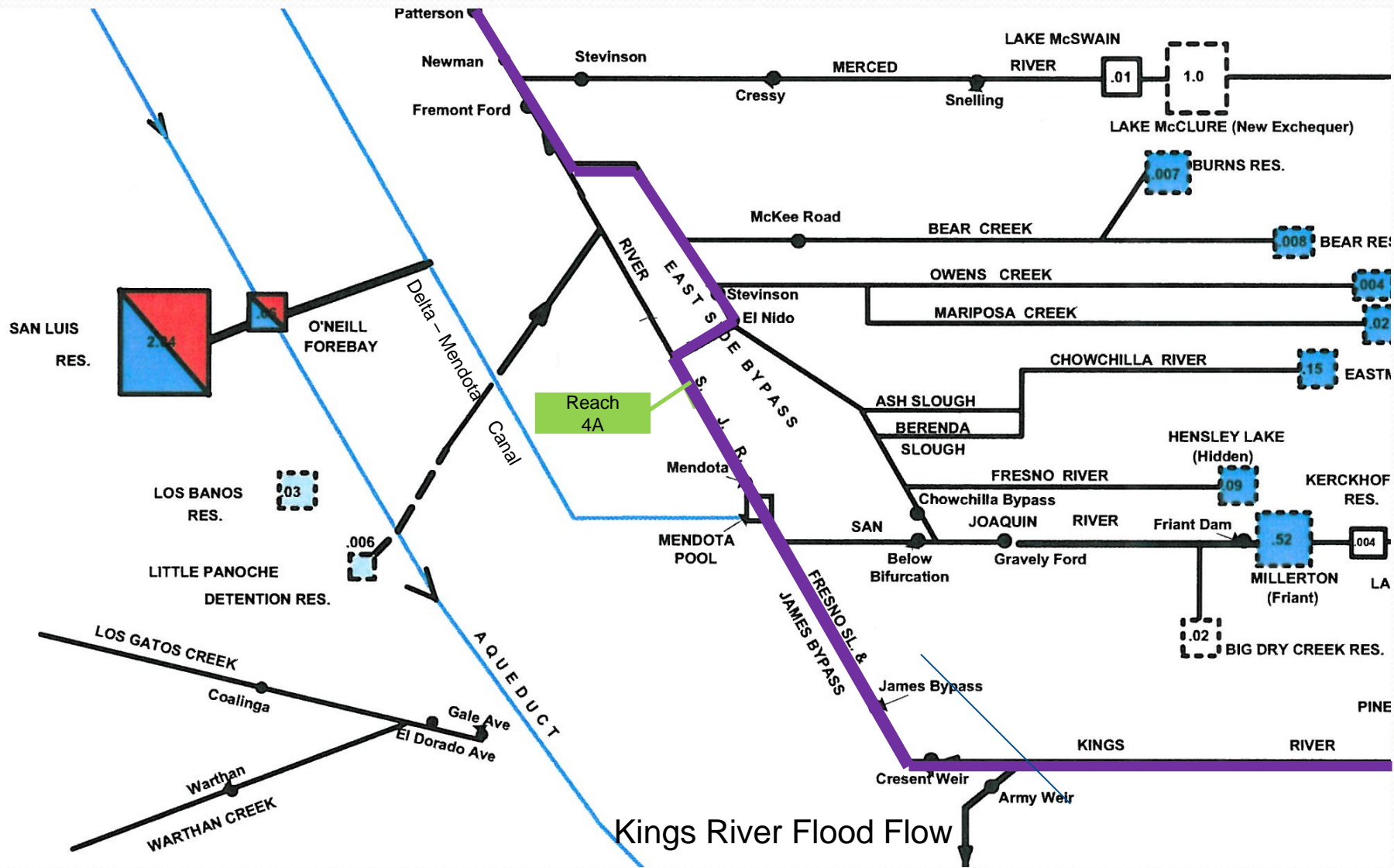






S.J. River Flood

Historic Water Supply

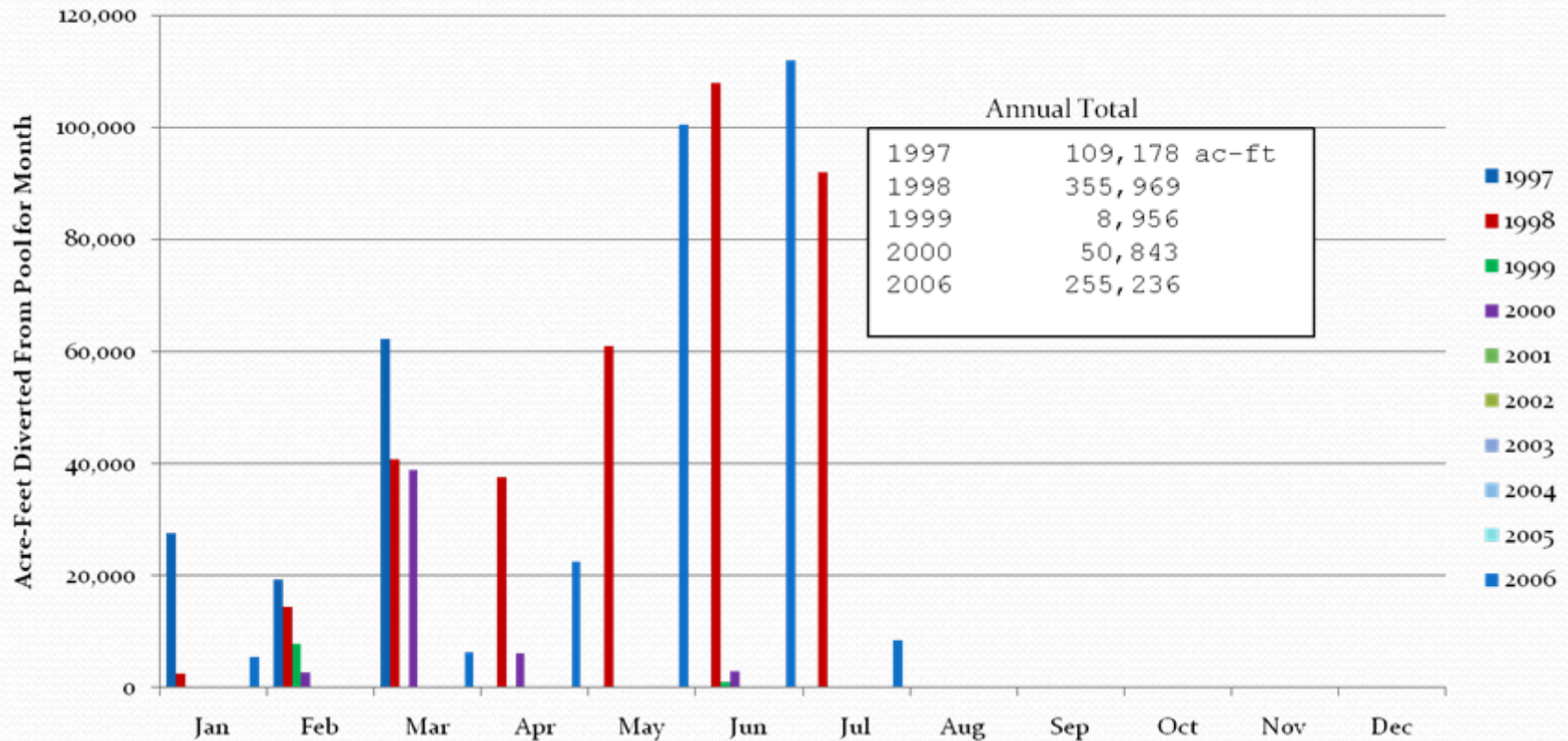
Opportunities from Friant Operations

South of Delta CVP Contractors have historically enjoyed water supply benefits from Millerton flood flows.

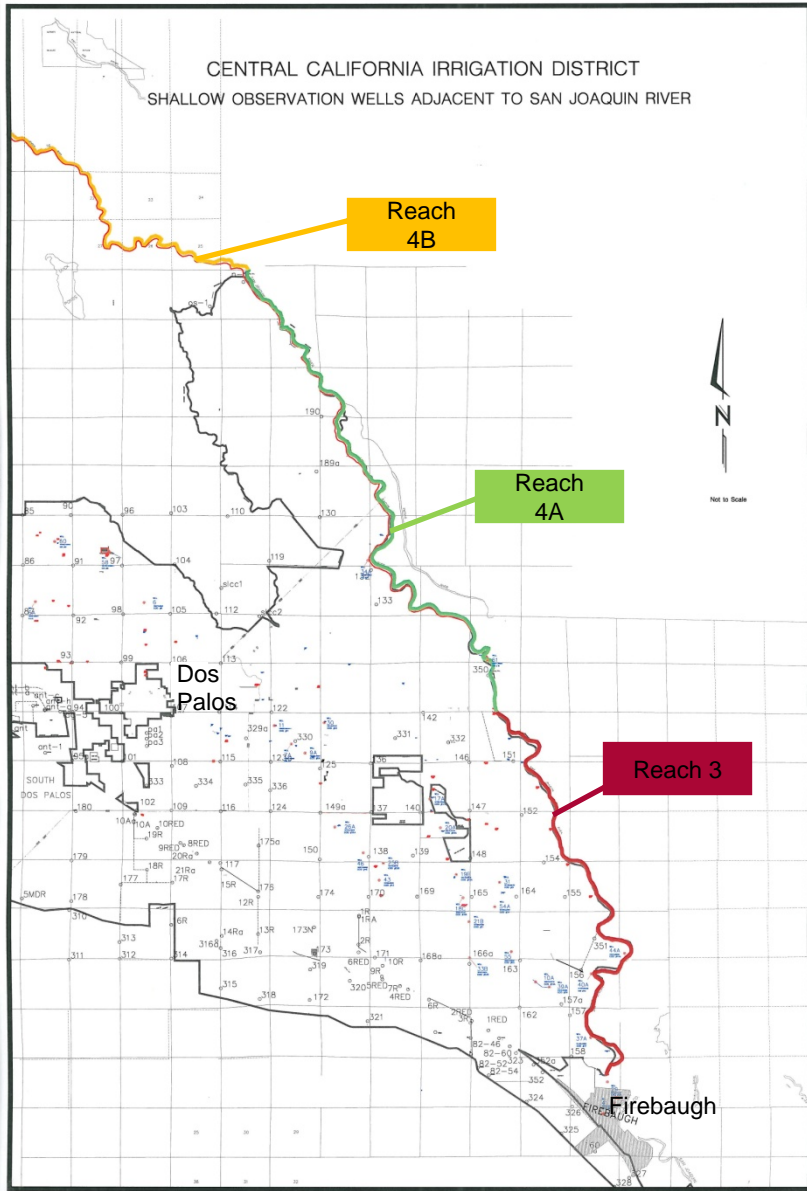
- Flood flows are used to meet Exchange Contractor demands in the Mendota Pool.
- Delta-Mendota Canal water that otherwise would have satisfied the Exchange Contractor demand absent the flood flows is therefore stored in San Luis Reservoir.
- The stored water is added to the total quantity of South of Delta CVP supplies available for allocation to M&I and Irrigation Contractors.

Actual Flood Flows Diverted

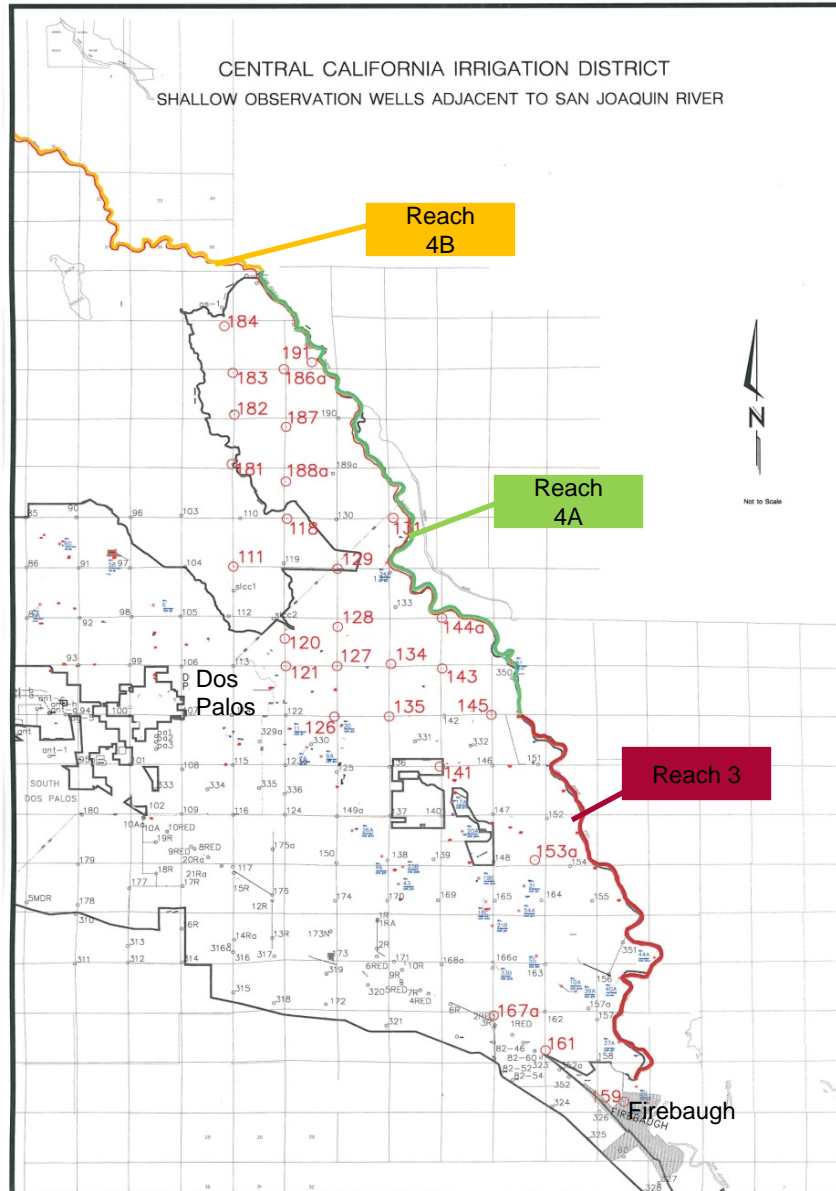
Usable Flood Flows to the Pool 1997-2006



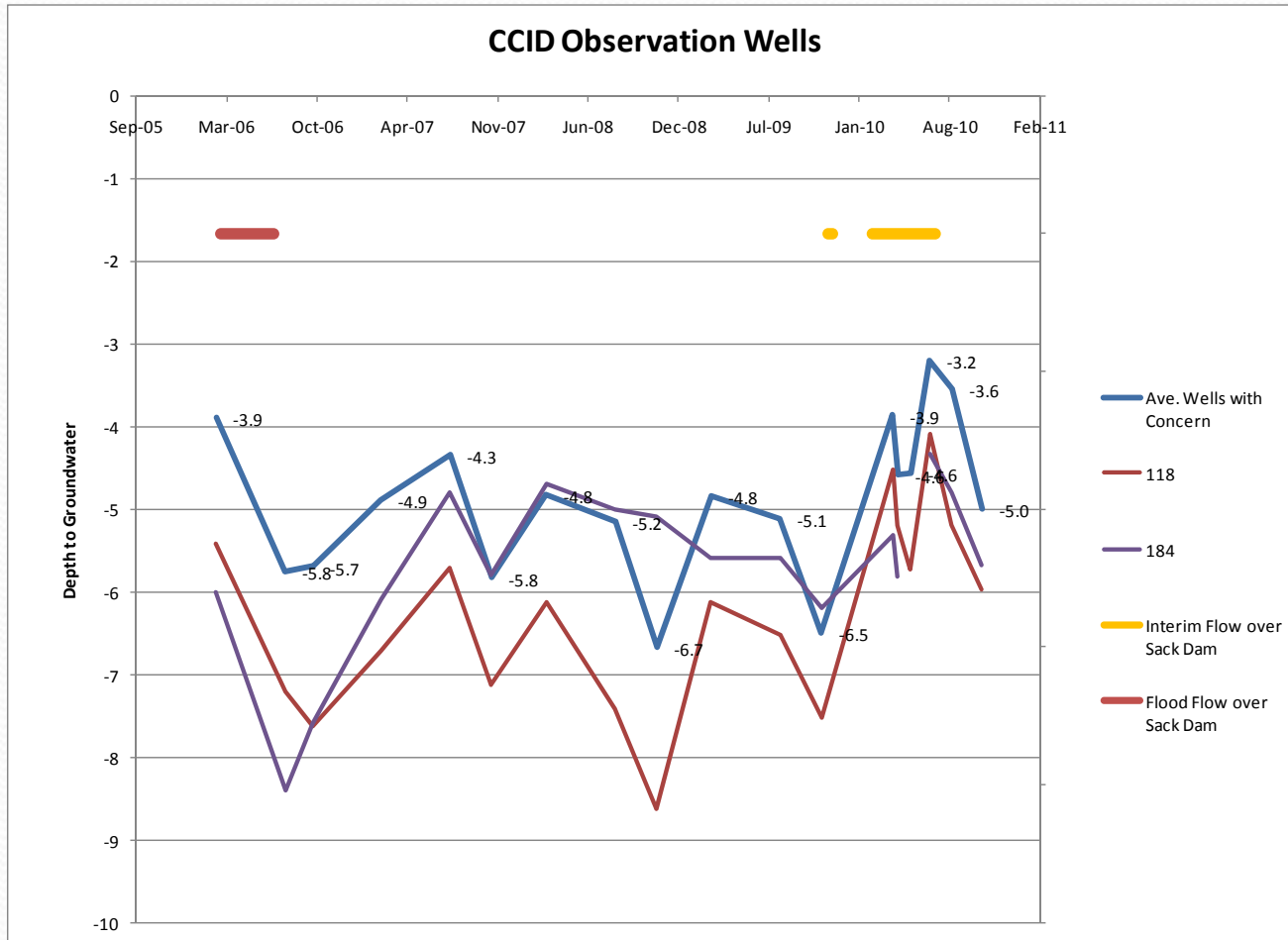
CENTRAL CALIFORNIA IRRIGATION DISTRICT
