## Dear Members:

At your workshop on March 19, you requested the Delta Vision Task Force provide our view on the priority of items which you might consider in the Delta work plan vou are developing.

Our Task Force met on March 20 and March 21 and unanimously adopted the following list of recommendations for your consideration. We believe top priority items should be:

- 1. Statewide conservation
- 2. Use of public trust, reasonable use, and no waste provisions of the Constitution
- 3. The need to identify and act on diversions within the Delta and Delta watershed
- 4. The need to identify and act on opportunities to integrate Board actions with those of other agencies and private parties to achieve California's policy goals
- 5. Protect species as part of water flow and water quality determinations
