State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board or Board) staff will be in Etna to assist water users in the Scott River and Shasta River watersheds with groundwater local cooperative solutions for the 2025 irrigation season.

After the presentation, individuals may ask questions about developing and submitting groundwater local cooperative solutions or meet individually with State Water Board staff to discuss a potential groundwater local cooperative solution proposal. While Coordinating Entities are not required under the emergency regulation, parties may choose to work with a Coordinating Entity. Coordinating Entity staff are invited to attend and discuss their role and how to coordinate with them.
