WHEREAS:

- Holman Ranch Holdings, LLC (Applicant) filed a water right application with the State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board), Division of Water Rights (Division), on January 19, 2007, requesting the right to divert 0.05 cubic foot per second by direct diversion and 6.3 acre-feet (af) by diversion to offstream storage, with an annual limit of 32.1 af from Carmel River Subterranean Stream.
- The Division noticed Application 31646 on March 13, 2008. The Division received protests on the
 application from the Ventana Chapter of the Sierra Club and a joint protest was received from
 Carmel River Steelhead Association and California Salmon and Steelhead Association. The
 protests are unresolved.
- On October 7, 2011, the Division received notice from the Applicant's agent requesting cancellation of Application 31646.
- 4. The State Water Board has delegated the authority to cancel applications to the Deputy Director of the Division pursuant to Resolution No. 2007-0057. The Deputy Director has redelegated this authority to the Assistant Deputy Director and Program Managers, pursuant to redelegation order dated October 4, 2007.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED THAT APPLICATION 31646 IS HEREBY CANCELED.

Applicant is hereby put on notice that any diversion of water from the point of diversion proposed under this application may be subject to administrative civil liability of up to \$500 per day without further notice, pursuant to Water Code section 1052. The State Water Board also may issue a cease and desist order in response to an unauthorized diversion or threatened unauthorized diversion pursuant to Water Code section 1831.

Applicant shall document any diversions made under claim of riparian or pre-1914 water rights by filing a Statement of Water Diversion and Use with the State Water Board in accordance with Water Code sections 5100 through 5108.
