Re: eWRIMS Workshop Comments

Dear Ms. Whitney:

Thank you for the opportunity to provide comments on the development of the eWRIMS software program pursuant to the November 3, 2006 Workshop. Wagner & Bonsignore Consulting Civil Engineers currently represents over 100 pending actions at the State Water Resources Control Board. We also represent over 150 additional clients with the ongoing administration of their existing Licenses, Permit, Statements, etc. We access and use the current WRIMS site daily.

Below are the key elements that we believe would be of most benefit to our firm and likely many others.

- License images on the WRIMS website should be available in PDF format for easy viewing and printing.
- Images of Permits and Orders should be added to the cWRIMS site.
- The GIS mapping system should use 7.5 minute U.S.G.S. quadrangle maps as a background image (the current WRIMS system uses 15 minute quadrangles).
- Correct the problem where application numbers overlap.
- The existing information presented in the WRIMS system should be checked regularly for accuracy and an email contact should be provided to notify the State Water Resources Control Board of corrections or errors discovered by users.
- Online reporting for Reports of License, Progress Reports and Supplemental Statements of Water Diversion and Use should be flexible so that attachments can be included in the filing.
