



Please do not support any action which will allow more salt to enter the Delta.

There are measures that can reduce the demands for more Delta water such as eliminating the use of rainbird type sprinklers in San Joaquin Valley farms and insisting on greater water conservation throughout the valley and in Southern California. Some communities do not allow washing vehicles on your property so that you will use car washes where they recycle water which uses much less water per wash. The waste from overwatering yards with water flowing into the gutters is prevalent in Southern California and elsewhere. While it isn't directly your responsibility, the number of illegal residents put incredible demands on the water systems.

Please take some affirmative actions to reduce the demands on the water resources and do not allow further salt water intrusion in the Delta.
