## Amendment No. 2 to the Cooperative Agreement for the Use of Los Vaqueros Reservoir for a One-Time Storage and Exchange Demonstration Project between Byron Bethany Irrigation District and Contra Costa Water District

This amendment ("Amendment") is made as of May 12, 2015 between Byron Bethany Irrigation District ("BBID") and Contra Costa Water District ("CCWD"), parties to the Cooperative Agreement for the Use of Los Vaqueros Reservoir for a One-Time Storage and Exchange Demonstration Project between Byron Bethany Irrigation District and Contra Costa Water District dated June 13, 2014 (the "Agreement") and Amendment No. 1 dated September 30, 2014.

## RECITALS

WHEREAS, delivery to BBID of water stored pursuant to this Agreement completed prior to October 31, 2014, was 1,656 acre-feet, which is less than the maximum amount of 4,000 acrefeet; and

WHEREAS, due to the continuing drought and potential for curtailment of BBID's water right in 2015, BBID has an urgent need for up to 500 acre-feet of alternative water supply for customers that require an uninterrupted supply, thus requiring an extension of the time allowed for delivery of the stored water in order to accomplish the purposes of the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, delivery to BBID of water stored pursuant to this Agreement was not completed prior to October 31, 2014, thus an extension of the time is necessary to allow for additional deliveries of the stored water in order to accomplish the purposes of the Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BBID and CCWD agree that the above recitals are hereby incorporated into and made a part of the Agreement, and further agree as follows:

- 1. Pursuant to Section 15 of the Agreement, the time period for the completion of the transfer of water stored pursuant to the Agreement is extended to December 31, 2015, and Sections 1, 3, and 5 of the Agreement shall be construed accordingly; and
- 2. Except as set forth in Section 1 of this Amendment, all provisions of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.
- 3. This Amendment may be executed in two or more counterparts, each of which together shall be deemed an original, but all of which together shall constitute one and the same instrument.
