CAREN TRGOVCICH: Chair Marcus, if I can just add as well that yesterday the Office of Administrative Law approved the conservation regulations. So we had originally anticipated it would be Friday the 15th, but it was actually yesterday. OAL's approval is about to be posted to our website, and we'll also be posting additional materials this week. So I want to be sure to include that in the drought update as well.

Yesterday -- well, I won't share it now, but I'll share some of the things that some of the large water agency board members seem to think we're doing, which is not what we're doing.

So it's clear -- it's great that you're doing the webinar with ACWA; that should help to spread the issues. So that at least when people are disagreeing with us, they're disagreeing with us based on reality rather than on some figment of somebody's imagination, so I thank you for
