WATER APPROPRIATION NOTICE.

I, T. C. MacChesney, a citizen of the United States and resident of San Jose, California, do hereby give notice that I locate, appropriate, and claim the flood, freshet, and all other waters flowing down the stream and past the point where this notice is posted which is on the Left Bank of the San Joaquin River at its point of intersection with the Banta Reclamation District Levee and is approximately N. 21½° E. 4900 feet from the corner of sections 3 and 4, 33 and 34 Tps. 2 and 3 S., R. 6 E., M.D.M., to the extent of 200 cubic feet per second, or 10000 Miners inches measured under a four inch pressure. I intend to divert said waters by means of a ditch having a bottom width of 18 feet and of sufficient depth to carry said amount of water and also by means of pumps of sufficient size to lift said amount of water.

I intend to use said waters for irrigation, domestic, power, and all other applied uses on the Westerly side of the San Joaquin Valley in San Joaquin and other Counties of California.
