Gentlemen:

An informal conference was held at this office at 10 o'clock on May 2nd, at which were present Mr. A. Kempkey and Mr. R. F. MacLeod, engineer and secretary, respectively, for the East Contra Costa Irrigation Company, Mr. W. G. Hunter, engineer for the West Side Irrigation District, and Mr. Chandler, Commissioner.

The conference was called to discuss the question of water supply, especially in regard to possible conflict between the West Side Irrigation District and the East Contra Costa Irrigation Company. It was agreed that all present indications point to an ample supply for both projects and it was explained that the protest of the East Contra Costa Irrigation Company had been filed so that there would be no question as to its priority.

In view of the above the Commission has approved the application of the West Side Irrigation District with the usual condition prescribed by statute, that such approval is subject to all existing rights.
