<u>Customer Class</u>	<u>Water Service Rates</u> Water is measured in units of one hundred cubic feet (hcf). One hcf equals 748 gallons. Allotments are monthly, except as indicated. See table below for monthly service charges, which are based on meter size and are in addition to metered water charges.	<u>Sewer Service Rates</u> Non-residential accounts are subject to a minimum monthly charge by meter size as shown in the table below.

Water Connection (Includes everything up to, and including, the meter at the road edge):	
1" service connection, with 5/8" meter:	\$1,897.00
Water buy-in fee, per new single-family residence:	\$2,805.00
Total:	\$4,702.00
Sewer Connection (Includes only the tap to the City sewer main. Trenching, lateral installation, backfill, and repaving are done by owner's private contractor)	
4" sewer line tap:	\$ 575.00
Trench inspection fee:	\$ 290.70

Sewer buy-in fee, per new single-family residence: **	\$2,240.00
Total:	\$3,105.70

* Assumes that extension of the City main line is not required.

** Through June 30, 2009, the sewer buy-in fee is reduced by 50% for conversions from septic tank to City sewer.
