In relation to the September 24 and 25 SWRCB hearing set for the Carmel River change petitions (Permits 20808 and 7130b), Arthur J. Baggett, Jr. set the deadline for submission of testimony and exhibits for September 7, 2007 (A. Baggett transmittal of August 29, 2007).

The parties continue to discuss settlement opportunities as well as other means to limit the scope of the hearing. These discussions have taken place on both August 31 and September 4, and an additional conference call is now calendared for September 5. Participants to date have included representatives of CAW, Cal. Fish & Game, NOAA Fisheries Service and MPWMD. Contact with CSPA is also planned.

To facilitate these efforts, it is requested that the deadline for submission of testimony and exhibits be extended one week for all parties, from September 7, 2007 to September 14, 2007. This additional time will foster continued settlement discussions, and allow the parties to better identify areas of agreement or at a minimum enable areas of dispute (if any remain) to be better refined. This request may allow the scope of the hearing on this matter to be greatly reduced.

Your immediate response to this request will be appreciated as all parties can only presume that the submission deadline is this Friday, unless we receive notice of its change.
