Objections by the California Fisheries and Water Unlimited

The California Fisheries and Water Unlimited have standing before the State Water Board in water right matters. The California Fisheries and Water Unlimited is not a protestant for said applications. However, the California Fisheries and Water Unlimited is an interested party and is part owner of the public trust resources and assets of the State of California. The president of the California Fisheries and Water Unlimited is Robert J. Baiocchi. He has testified as an expert witness before the State Water Board in other water right matters, He will not testify in this hearing matter and objects as follows:

Clearly water right applications and petitions approved by the State Water Board or its staff have adversely impacted the environment of the Bay Delta Estuary, including Central Valley endangered salmon species and threatened steelhead species. I reference the records.

The Cities of Woodland and Davis applied for 45,000 acre-feet of water to serve their people. The Cities applications seek said amount of water from January 1 to December 31 of all year regardless of water year conditions. The use of water for domestic purposes has the highest priority, provide the water is used for domestic purposes such as drinking water and not irrigation and industrial purposes. The Cities claim an overriding consideration regardless of the impacts to the environment of the Bay Delta Estuary and claim no significant effects to Sacramento River and Delta. We disagree and object because of the cumulative effects to the Bay Delta Estuary resulting from all water right applications and petitions approved by the State Water Board or its staff, which now includes the applications by

the Cities. The Cities EIR claims overriding considerations. Overriding considerations do not pre-empt the federal Clean Water Act; the federal Endangered Species Act; the Public Trust Doctrine; the state Endangered Species Act; and many other legal environmental protect measures, including court decisions.

There are many formal Protestants that are attempting to protect their interests. The State Water Contactors do not want their water deliveries affected by said applications. The California Department of Water Resources does not want their water rights affected by said applications. The US Bureau of Reclamation does not want their water rights affected by said applications. The Westland Water District does not want their water deliveries affected by said applications. The City of Sacramento does not want their water rights affected by said applications. Various Protestants and most likely rice growers' et al do not want their water rights and also water deliveries affected by said applications.

However all of the above parties and the state's water that they receive either by permits or deliveries have affected the environment of the Bay Delta Estuary.

The Bay Delta Estuary must be repaired from the damages and harm caused from all water diversions caused by water right petitions and applications. That includes the effects to endangered salmon; threatened steelhead; other endangered species; water quality, et al. of the Bay Delta Estuary.

The State Water Board and its staff must stop approving water petitions and applications until the Bay Delta Estuary is repaired meaningfully. That means changes to water rights permits and water deliveries by all parties. The water rights dilemma must stop for the good of the people and that water uses are finally balanced by the State Water Board to protect the people's trust assets.

I object to said applications being approved as submitted. Water for domestic uses for the people of the Cities of Woodland and Davis should only be approved provided there are reductions to water deliveries for the same amount to the Central Valley Project (Shasta Reservoir) and the State Water Project (Oroville Reservoir) water deliveries.

My questions are: How much water does the City of Woodland need for domestic purposes? How much water does the City of Davis need for domestic purpose? How much water are the cities saving on water conservation management plans for domestic purposes that have been approved by the State Water Board?

For the Board to further compound the adverse impacts to the environment of the Bay Delta Estuary and approve 45,000 acre-feet of water to the Cities would be a continuation of making the wrong water rights decisions that have significantly affected the environment of the By Delta Estuary without balancing the uses of water and protecting he Bay Delta Estuary.

Place these objections and comments into the records for the hearing. Provide copies of the above comments and objections to the Protestants and the applicants, and post the comments and the objections on the State Water Board website. Place the name of the California Fisheries and Water Unlimited on the mailing list for all submittals. Forward all submittals electronically to the representative shown below.
