Dear Mr. Buckman:

The State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board), Division of Water Rights' (Division) prosecution team and Younan A. Dawood and Sandra C. Dawood (collectively the Dawoods) have reached a settlement in principle in regard to Enforcement Action ENF00127 – an Administrative Civil Liability Complaint and a draft Cease and Desist Order (CDO) issued to the Dawoods. The parties are in the process of memorializing the terms of the settlement agreement and presenting it to the Executive Director for his consideration.

It is my understanding from conversations with Mr. Nathan Dawood that a Notice of Intent to Appear was timely filed via facsimile by the May 22, 2014 deadline. Regardless, the prosecution team is requesting an extension of the June 5, 2014 deadline for receipt and service of testimony, exhibits, lists of exhibits, qualifications, and statement of service (submissions deadline). The prosecution team is requesting that the submissions deadline be extended for all parties until June 19, 2014.
