


Dear Ms. Doduc:

El Sur Ranch ("ESR") and the California Department of Fish and Wildlife ("CDFW") are updating you on the status of conversations with other hearing participants concerning the settlement terms reached by ESR and CDFW. By our correspondence to you dated January 31, 2019, we stated that we would reach out to the other hearing participants and report back to you within 45 days.
