My name is Jim Cunningham. I
am 74 years old and fished both Little
+ Big Sun rivers since I was 14 years young.

During this time I have caught many
hundreds of steel head and salmon. Most

catches were recorded during the winter
runs from Dec th 7th - Mar 15.

However it was not uncommon to
fish the lower 4 miles of Big Sun

river + catch fresh steelhead + silver

salmon + dog salmon, from Aug, Sept

+ Oct. However I did see salmon

that had spawned + were actively dying

in late Dec. These are facts and

can be substantiated with photos. I hope

this statement brings enlightenment to

the fact that with water conditions
acceptable (i.e. water flowing thru river
and access ~~to~~ to the ocean allows
these fish to survive albeit in
smaller numbers than we would like
