- Completed the first Groundwater Resources Development Report Identifying potential for groundwater in the Authority's service area
- Implemented an econometric computer model to optimize resource mixes over 20+ year planning horizon

Duties were: economic and financial analyses of reclaimed water and groundwater projects; Identified opportunities for local project funding; assisted member agencies in complying with department of health services and regional board criteria; public education, and outreach; legislative analysis; administration of local project funding programs. - Developed and implemented the Reclaimed Water Development Fund to achieve 50,000 acre feet of new local water supply
- Negotiated an MOU among 7 local agencies to share up to \$200 million in federal construction grants over a multi-year period
