**THE BEALE CLOCK TOWER**  
**BAKERSFIELD, CALIFORNIA**

Erected in 1904 as a memorial to Mary Edward Beale, wife of  
Kern County pioneer Edward F. Beale, the tower and its  
thousand-pound bell remained a familiar landmark at 17th  
and Chester Avenue until it was damaged by two earthquakes  
in 1952 and demolished. The 64-foot Moorish-design tower  
was reconstructed in the late 1950's and today stands in front  
of the Kern County Museum.

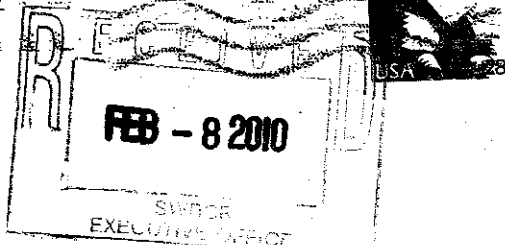
