Modification and Long-Term Transfer Petition**

Dear Mr. Baggett:

During the December 5 hearing on the above petitions, you stated that the hearing record would remain open for me to submit a letter advising you of the execution by the Yuba County Water Agency ("YCWA") and the Pacific Gas and Electric Company ("PG&E") of the amendment to the YCWA/PG&E 1966 Power Purchase Contract that is necessary so that YCWA can implement the Yuba Accord.

This letter is to advise you that YCWA and PG&E have executed this amendment, which satisfies the requirements of section 4.4 of the Lower Yuba River Fisheries Agreement (exh. YCWA-9) and clause (4) of section 3 of the Yuba Accord Water Purchase Agreement (exhs. YCWA-11 & YCWA-11a).

Now that this amendment has been executed, the only remaining contingency that needs to be satisfied for the Lower Yuba River Fisheries Agreement to go into effect is the SWRCB's approval of YCWA's two pending change petitions for the Yuba Accord (see Lower Yuba River Fisheries Agreement, exh. YCWA-9, § 4.1).
